LIBRARY CARD

This is a Library card. I will need to bring my Library card with me if I want to bring materials home with me.







This is the Library Lobby. I need to go through the Lobby to visit Kids Landing.





There is an area to have a snack and a large room for events.





The Lobby is a large space.

I will see a desk, stair,
and an elevator.





There are public restrooms in the Lobby. The toilets will flush automatically, and the hand dryers make a loud noise.



This is where I enter the room that has books and activities for me.





This is where the librarians work.

I can ask questions. They can help
me find what I am looking for.





I can build things with blocks, play games, and color in the Discovery Corner. I might have to share or wait for my turn.





I can use iPads and computers in Kids Landing. I will need my Library card or ask a librarian for a guest pass to use a computer.





I can play with Duplo bricks, trains, and animals in the Play Area.
There is also a play store to pretend in.
I can sort colors and make patterns with the light up peg board. I might have to share or wait for my turn.





I can use the supplies in Discovery Spot to make crafts.





There are different places to sit in Kids Landing. I can choose a comfortable place to sit and read.









There are two small family restrooms in Kids Landing. I can go there by myself or with my adult to use the restroom. The hand dryers make a loud noise.





I can visit the Discovery Terrace and play outside when the weather is nice.





There are different places in the Library where I can attend programs with other people.







I might attend a Storytime in the Discovery Spot or a class in the Discovery Corner.









I might attend a family program in the Meeting Room or a class in the Computer Lab.







I might attend a demonstration in the DIY Workshop, or create something with the 3D printer. These areas are upstairs on the second floor.

I may hear the sounds of noisy equipment like computers, printers, vacuum cleaners, and the carts that move Library materials around the Library.








When I am done visiting the

I can also take my Library card and materials to the library staff at the Customer Service desk in the Lobby. If I want to check out a video game, I will need to go to this desk. I might need to wait for my turn.

I borrowed, I will return them to
the Library. I will return them in the
Lobby or at the drive-up window.
